

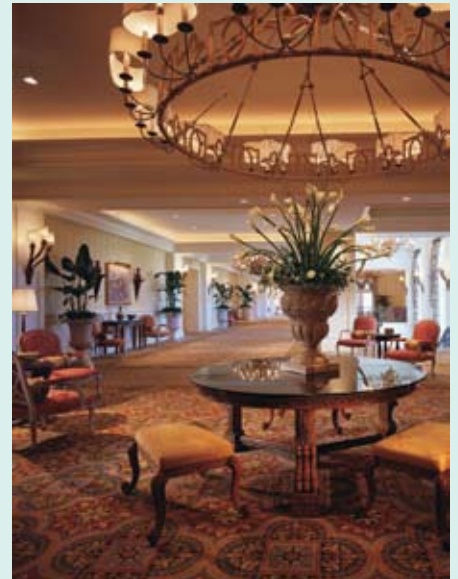
Both Valet and Self Parking are available. Valet parking is \$19 per night and self parking is \$12 per night.(Subject to change)
